Dear Cal State LA International Students:

We understand this is a difficult time for you as an incoming Cal State LA international students. International Programs and Global Education (IPGE) wants to provide you with as much information as possible so that you can make a well-informed decision regarding your health and safety.

The COVID-19 situation is improving in California and Los Angeles County. The State officially reopened on June 15, 2021, including schools, theme parks, restaurants, theatres, public parks among other locations and destinations. Please follow these guidelines when in California and Los Angeles:

- Face coverings are still required in certain public facilities. Watch for signs that tell you to wear a face covering.
- At Cal State LA, you will see signs about requirements for face coverings placed on/in buildings, elevators and stairwells, and across campus.
- When on campus, face coverings are required when you are indoors.

## **INTERNATIONAL VACCINES**

The decision about international vaccines is currently under deliberation at the California State Chancellors (CSU) Office. We will update our website once we receive more information. Please note that anyone in the United States who is 16 years of age or older can receive a vaccine, irrespective of immigration status.
