




Seniors Spring 2022: Knowing our Undergraduate Seniors




In Spring 2022, seniors were invited to participate in the Senior Survey designed to learn about their undergraduate experience and post-graduation plans.





WHEN DO YOU EXPECT TO GRADUATE?





Multiple Priorities Impact Time to Graduation



Seniors attend to various demands as they progress towards a degree. Their need to balance academic work, extracurricular commitments, and personal demands, impact their time to graduation.

TOP 5 CHALLENGING EXPERIENCE AT CAL STATE LA



SENSE OF COMMUNITY/ BELONGING

Cal State LA promoted a positive sense of belonging. Students felt welcome and developed meaningful and supportive relationships with peers, faculty, and staff.



LACK OF GUIDANCE

Students received inconsistent information, spent insufficient time with advisors, or were unaware of supports available. First year students and first-generation students particularly felt lost.



FACULTY

University faculty cared about their students and provided quality learning opportunities.



NOT ENOUGH FACULTY SUPPORT

Students received inadequate support, both personally and academically, from faculty, particularly during the pandemic.



LEARNING EXPERIENCES

The university offered positive and meaningful educational experiences for students through course curriculum and various learning opportunities.



COVID

COVID presented various challenges for students: concern for health and well-being, transition from face-to-face to online learning, and lack of college experience due to the lockdown.



DIVERSITY

Cal State LA is a diverse environment that allowed students to meet many new people from whom they learned



COURSE OFFERINGS

Students couldn't find classes that fit their schedules or in the modality that they wanted. This was particularly critical for students who worked or commuted.



LOCATION/PROXIMITY TO HOME

The campus's location within Los Angeles made the university close to home and/or work and allowed for an easy commute. The DTLA campus was also a convenient location for students.



CAMPUS ENVIRONMENT

Campus environment was not conducive to an enjoyable campus life experience for various reasons (e.g., not enough campus activities or events to join, outdated buildings, poor lighting at night, difficulty navigating the campus).

Communicate effectively about campus events & services, and students' progress.

Offer greater availability of courses in terms of time & modality to ensure timely graduation.



IMPROVED ADVISING & GUIDANCE

Offer to all students clear and accurate guidance in their academic progress.

Create a safe campus environment that is inviting, engaging, and creates a positive college experience for students.
