6. Liaison Reports

6.1. <u>Executive Committee Liaison Report</u>

- President Covino shared with Executive Committee on 11/4 that the university has surpassed their donor goal of \$75 million by the 75th anniversary year. The university has already reached \$100 million in donor gifts.
- President Covino also shared that across the CSU, approximately 80% of all classes will be in person and 20% will be online for Spring 2022 semester.
- Cal State LA will be approximately 75-80% in person for Spring 2022 semester.
- An update on CAPS: 1 new full-time counselor was hired at the end of October. His name is Daniel Benitez. Also, interviews are currently taking place to hire more counselors.
