Partial or non-payment of tuition and fees by the billing deadline date may result in a hold being placed on the student's account, possible disenrollment from the current term, and forfeiture of tuition and fees payments already made. Students may also become ineligible to participate in a payment plan for two consecutive terms.

Students who drop all courses on or after the first day of the term and up to the 60% point, or as otherwise specified on the proration schedule for each session, will be charged prorated tuition and fees based on the drop date.
