
Student Success Fee

Allocation Summary

Fiscal Year 2014-15

At Cal State L.A., the Student Success Fee supports the Student Success, Graduation and Career Placement Initiative. This initiative places emphasis on four priorities for student success: Academic Advisement and Retention, Student Development, Career Services, and Vital Technologies.

In 2014-15, more than \$5.4 million was allocated (see Graph 1) to enhanced academic advisement services, mentoring and tutoring support, community-based learning, extended library hours, Summer Bridge programs, career services, veterans support, 24-hour open access lab, Just-in-Time learning, and Anywhere On-Demand applications.



Program allocations were made to the divisions of Academic Affairs (\$2.8 million), Information Technology Services (\$1.2 million), and Student Affairs and Enrollment Management (\$1.3 million). These divisions are responsible for the development and implementation of the Student Success, Graduation and Career Placement Initiative.

Academic Affairs

Academic Affairs will launch new program initiatives, such as Peer Mentors for International Students, technology enhancements to the Graduate Student Resource Center, extended library hours, and additional peer tutors for the tutorial center. Student Success Fee allocations also supplement existing resources dedicated to academic advising, tutoring, and other support programs. The \$2.8 million is allocated as follows:

Information Technology Services

Through the Student Success Fee, the division provides student access to an expansive selection of learning resources. These include Anywhere On-Demand Applications; Anytime, Anywhere Access; Just-In-Time Learning; Adobe Creative Cloud for Students; Microsoft Office and Windows for Students; and a new technology vulnerability assessment. The \$1.2 million is allocated as follows:
