## How many course sections should I be scheduling?

In order to determine how many sections, first determine the number of majors and class level.

Example: Daily Major Report - Business major

How many LD, UD, and Grad courses should be offered?
Example: Business course offerings

- Based on the daily major report, and using the BUS degree roadmap, calculate $1 / 4$ of your majors per LD or UD course offerings.
- For instance, BUS has 1114 LD majors and 5 core LD requirements. The number of students who need the course ( $1 / 4$ of 1114 ) will determine how many sections you will need to offer that term.
