*Upper Division General Education Requirements:

Students are required to complete 9 units of upper division general education courses distributed across three subject areas: Humanities, Natural Sciences, and Social Sciences.

NOTE: If you have not taken a lower division course to meet the Nutrition requirement, you can take NTRS 3510 to fulfill Nutrition & UD GE Block B.

- Additionally, the following requirements must be met with the upper division general education courses selected:
- Civic Learning/Community Engagemnt Requirement (6 semester units). One (cl) course must be completed at the upper division general education level.
- Diversity Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete one race/ethnicity (re) course and one diversity (d) course or another race/ethnicity (re) course.
- Writing Intensive Requirement (6 semester units). Students must complete two writing intensive (wi) courses, with at least one in their major.
