Students interested in pursuing the Integrated Option (BA + Credential) will still follow this roadmap. The only difference is that these students must complete all sections of the appropriate examinations (CBEST and/or CSET) as soon as possible and maintain a 2.75 grade point average. All students interested in teaching should meet with a Liberal Studies advisor early on to go over the coursework they need to take (Directed Electives and Depth Area courses) to prepare for these exams, and all students should begin the application process for their desired credential programs over the summer after their first year.
