Management Payment Plan (MPP) - 4 Payments

The MPP enrollment fee is \$35.00**. **The due dates for this plan are November 1, 2021; December 1, 2021; January 1, 2022 and February 1, 2022.** *If your enrollment appointment is before November 1st, you must complete the first installment on or before your appointment date in order to register for classes on that date. The last day to sign up for this plan is December 1st, 2021;* however, both the November and December payments must be made to enroll at that time.

The MPP payment breakdown below does not include Non-Resident Fee or Graduate Business Professional Program Fees. The option to add Non-Resident Fees and/or Graduate Business Professional Program Fees to your plan is available during the enrollment process.

** *The \$35.00 enrollment fee is not included in the payments below and will be added to the first payment at the time of enrollment into the plan. Enrollment fees are non-refundable.*
