WORK/VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE

Must be completed in the U.S.A.

The applicant can only submit only one specific type of experience for either work or volunteer experience in which they have directly worked with patients with 50 or more hours of service within the last 2 years:

- **a.** <u>As an employee</u> Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN), Respiratory Therapist (RT), Psychiatric Technician, Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Medical Assistant (MA), Lab Technician, or Pharm Tech are examples.
 - Upload proof of employment license in the "Shadowing" category.
- **b.** <u>As health related experience</u> Regional Occupational Program (ROP) or Career Technical Education (CTE program)
 - Upload proof of program activity.

c. As volunteer/community enrichment

- Acceptable locations for volunteer hours are:
 - Hospitals, Medical clinics, Nursing clinics, Student Health Center, home health care/nursing homes.
 - Any position where you are following an RN or CNA
- Volunteer hours are accepted from the last 2 years only and may increase the probability of being admitted but the hours are not mandatory.

An acceptable verification letter includes the following:

- Report the volunteer hours and the type of duties performed in a letter on official letterhead.
- Indicate the number of hours and/or days, the volunteering was performed.
- The supervisor or lead, signs the form and includes employment position, work phone number, work email address for contacting.
